Course Description

A supervised practical experience with a community or social agency related to the student's interest and/or future plans. Readings, written assignments and group meetings will help students reflect on and integrate knowledge with practical experience.

Objectives

- Students are to volunteer 3-5 hours per week over a 10 week period
- Establish learning and personal goals for supervised practicum experience
- Begin to integrate theoretical issues in psychology and sociology with practical knowledge
- Gain valuable work experience
