Pastoring in the North American Chinese Church (PT 650-CM) Instructor: Dr. Titus Yu

I. Course Description:

This course explores key contemporary issues and challenges related to pastoral ministry in a Chinese church context. The purpose of this course is to examine church ceremonies and apply student's theological understanding to local church ministry practice. Chinese churches in North America are bi-cultural. Local church pastors need to be sensitive to the language and the background of the congregation when performing church ceremonies. Relevant biblical responses and pastoral methodologies for ministering to the 21st Century Chinese churches in North America will be examined. This course is taught in Cantonese.

II. Course Expectations and Objectives:

- a. To examine and to evaluate the theological, biblical and cultural principles behind each of these ceremonies, such as: baptism, communion, anointing for healing, baby dedication, funeral service, wedding service, installation service, and ordination service.
- b. To understand the role as a chairperson in the Chinese Elder Broad, the role as a peacemaker-pastor in Chinese churches, the role in the testimonies against the powers of darkness/demonic spirits, the role as a discipleship trainer, the role of an every-Sunday-preacher and the role as a pastoral counselor.
- c. To rehearse some of the above ceremonies.
- d. To learn to apply each of the ceremonies in a local church setting, as it may differ depending upon church size and congregation.
- e. To discuss real life pastoral ministry issues, provided by the students.
