

ARCHIBALD SCHOLARSHIP

Vision

Scholarships are made available to seminary students who have a clear call to and desire to serve in full time ministry. This call can fulfill itself either in fulltime missions work or full time local church ministry.

Target Area

The main target area will be towards men and women who are part of the Christian and Missionary Alliance Church youth groups and college and career groups.

Terms of Award

The scholarship will be awarded to someone who has completed an undergraduate degree and desires to attend Ambrose University.

The money will be used to offset the student's tuition bill during their first year of study. The award will be given in two equal portions over the first two semesters. In the event that a student's bill is paid in full the award will sit as a credit and be applied to the next semester's tuition.

Criteria for the Scholarship

1. A desire to serve in full time Christian ministry either:
 - a) Overseas with the Christian and Missionary Alliance
 - b) In North America as a full time vocational pastor with the Christian and Missionary Alliance.
2. Must be enrolled full time (12 credit hours) in a program of study at Ambrose Seminary.

Determination of Scholarship Winner

The scholarship will be based on an essay written by the applicant in approximately 500 words to the following question:

"Describe your Call to Ministry, giving details as to how you will meet that call, where you see your ministry taking place and why you feel Ambrose Seminary is the place to prepare for ministry."

PLUS:

A reference form to be fill out by their pastor seeking his/her discernment as to the individual's call to ministry, present involvement in their local church and what it is they bring to their local church that makes it a better place.
